It's a nice golf course and there's a lot of tradition behind it. The layout is very challenging but the condition is very good. You need to put the ball on the fairway obviously on the longer holes and the rough is also up around the greens. I'll be working on my chipping before the first round. The par fives are pretty scorable.

I feel like I'm playing well. Was a bit unfortunate in Singapore and Bangladesh where I missed the cut by one and two shots. I'm hitting the ball well but my putting has been on and off. Hopefully I can put it together this week.

I've been spending time on my chipping and putting. I came here early on Monday to play 18 holes and had nine holes yesterday and today to know the course better. It's good that Maybank, GlobalOne and the Asian Tour have decided to give out invites to Asean players which is a good initiative. It's a step in the right direction to grow the game further.

It's not always about the prize money. You still have to play good golf on any given week. Definitely, there's a different feeling when you step into a big event but you just come here to play the golf course and not worry about the field.

I think I can improve on my mental side of the game and my concentration levels plus my confidence. Sometimes, I tend to have little lapses during the round. Going forward I will work on those aspects.
