"Any time you finish comfortable inside the top ten, it's been a pretty solid week.

"Yesterday probably cost me a good chance of winning but I'm proud of the way I came back today.

"You're just trying to hit one shot at a time and see what goes. If you do then put a run together and get it to the turn in four, five under, then you can think about it but you've got to treat this course with a lot of respect, you can't just go hard at it.

"If you do, it can come off but you can rack up some big numbers as well. It's one of those courses where you need a lot of patience, especially in the heat. That's something I've done very well this week. I've kept pretty calm inside and tried to stay on a level playing field the whole week whether it's good or bad.

"We're all here to win but there's only guy that's going to do it. Any time you finish top five, top ten, your game is in good shape, especially in a world class field.

"No matter what tournament you play now, top ten is very respectable, so I'm proud of the way I played this week and this year. It's been a good start.

"I've been out here 13 or 14 years now so I've been there, done that. You're always frustrated if you've played badly or had a bad finish, that's just the way it is.

"We care, we work and we want the best and when it doesn't go our way, it's frustrating. But I try not to sit on it too long anymore."
